What we provide.

Provide kits for children and young people entering emergency foster care via A&E

Through our foster packs programme, we donate unisex backpacks to hospitals and trusts containing everything a person would need to spend a night away from home. The backpacks contain a change of clothes, toiletries and comforts such as a book and a cuddly toy.

Provide kits for children and young people in need of comfort at hospital

During the coronavirus pandemic, hospitals we worked with found that patients who were isolating found it difficult to receive items from family and friends. As a charity we responded and supported them in providing kits to any child or young person who needed the essentials.

Provide kits for New and Expectant Mothers arriving at hospital with no belongings

We have also expanded our service to mothers and expectant mothers fleeing situations like domestic abuse and human trafficking, we donate kits with selected clothes and comforts to support them.
